**IMPORTANT DEADLINES
(Anchorage, AK)**

- The dates below apply to the *Fall Semester 2009* cohort beginning in **Anchorage, AK**. Cohorts beginning in different semesters and locales may have different deadlines. For more information, please call (907) 786-4171.
- **June 26, 2009:** Deadline for receipt of **Complete Pre-Application Forms** in the CBPP Student Information Office, RH 309.
- **July 1, 2009:** Deadline for online submission of **UAA Applications for Admission**. All applications after July 1, 2009 will be processed as Spring 2010 admissions. Qualified applicants who submit their Pre-Application Forms between July 1 and September 1 may, at the discretion of the program director, be allowed to register in Fall 2009 classes on a space-available basis. However, such late applicants may be disqualified for financial aid or employer reimbursements. See back of page for additional information and instructions.
- **August 15, 2009:** Deadline for registration in **Fall 2009 MS GSCM classes**, and for **tuition payment arrangements** for the first course.
 - Tuition assistance is available on a limited basis.
 - For tuition payment, students may use Visa, MasterCard, check or tuition assistance. Some organizations require applications for tuition assistance up to 45 days *before* the start of a course. It is highly recommended that students seek out this information from their organizations as soon as possible. The first course begins September 12, 2009.
- **Course Weekends:** The first two of the five courses will be LOG A661 and LOG A663
 - Students are given weekend dates for two semesters at the start of every semester.
 - **Class Time:** Saturday (8:00am – 8:00pm) & Sunday (8:00 am – 4:00pm).

How to Apply for Admission Online

To apply for admission, go to <https://uaonline.alaska.edu> . If you don't already have a logon id and password, follow directions to create them. Write them down and then log in.

- On the main menu, click "Student Services, Financial Aid, and Account Information."
- On the next menu, click "Admissions."
- Click "Choose a Campus" and then select "University of Alaska Anchorage."
- On the next menu under "Application Type," select "Graduate (Bachelors Required)."
- Click "Continue."
- Select your admission term. UAA's deadline for Fall 2009 admission is July 1, 2009. However, if you have received a letter from the Logistics Department in response to your Pre-Application stating that you are eligible for conditional or full admission, you may be permitted to register (with permission of the program director) in Fall 2009 LOG A661.
- On the "Fill Out Application" menu, when you get to "Planned Course of Study," go down the list until you find "Global Supply Chain Management."
- Continue to follow the menu until you have completed your application.
- Pay the application fee online with a credit card at the time you apply. If you don't pay the application fee, the application will not be downloaded for processing.

How to Register Online

Before you try to register online, email Janet Burton (anjeb@cbpp.uaa.alaska.edu) and request clearance to register. (Registration in MS GSCM graduate classes is blocked, and the computer must be manually set to accept individual registrations.)

- Go to <https://uaonline.alaska.edu>
- Log in using the id and password you created when applying for admission.
- Click on "Student Services, Financial Aid and Account Information."
- Click on "Registration."
- Follow the menu, which is pretty straightforward. Regardless of when you register, the payment deadline for this class is August 15, 2009.

Erroneous Nonresident Tuition Charges

The correct amount for Fall 2009 LOG A661 is \$3636, plus a 2% network fee. The M.S. Global Supply Chain Management program does not charge non-resident tuition; however, the Banner computer erroneously applies nonresident tuition unless you are coded as an Alaska resident. If you are charged nonresident tuition, please email Janet Burton (anjeb@cbpp.uaa.alaska.edu), and the Logistics Department will request that it be removed. [If you are a resident and have not yet done so, you can get coded as such in Banner by submitting a Residency Form to UAA Enrollment Services with appropriate backup.
