- <sup>2</sup> No more than a total of six credits earned in an Independent Study, or ECON 454 (Economics Internship), may be used to satisfy requirements for the major (6 hours of Independent Study or 3 credits Independent Study and 3 credits of ECON 454).
- <sup>3</sup> ECON 201 and ECON 202 cannot be used to satisfy the Social Science GER requirement for this degree.
- <sup>4</sup> Admission to Upper-Division Standing does not waive individual course prerequisites (e.g., course pre-requisites for BA 377 are: BA 273 and MATH 272).
- <sup>5</sup> **ECON 488 is the preferred Integrative Capstone for Economic majors and may be used as any type of Elective.**

**NOTE:** A total of 120 credits are required for the BBA degree. At least 50% of the credits required for the BBA degree must be earned at the University of Alaska Anchorage. A minimum of 48 upper-division credits is required. **A grade of "C" or better is required for all ACCT, BA, CIS, ECON & LOG courses.**
