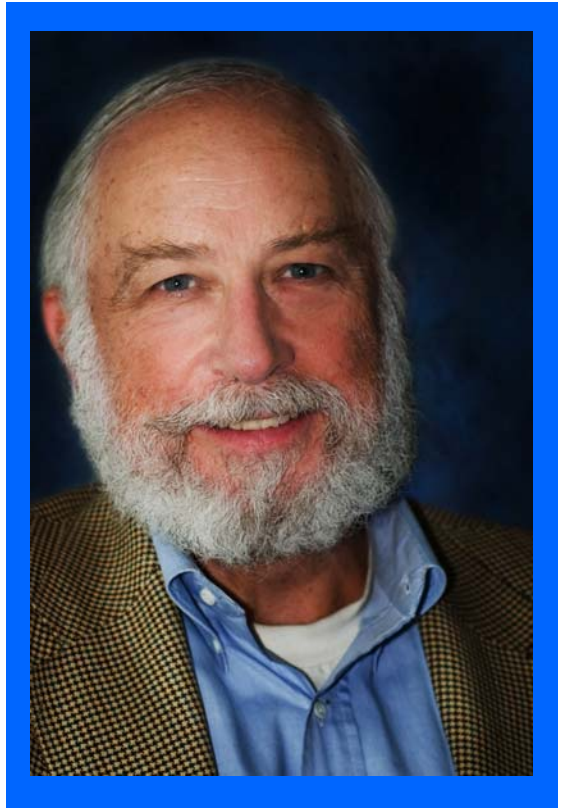

Brian Saylor, PhD, MPH

Dr. Saylor joined the Public Administration Department as part time faculty in Fall 2007 Semester, following 8 years as Director of the Institute for Circumpolar Health Studies.

He has completed numerous evaluations of state and local health and social welfare issues and has extensive experience teaching in the areas of health sciences, health administration, social research, evaluation research, public finance, and public policy.



Class Description
