* The BA Economics degree allows 45-53 credits of elective courses. We recommend the student consider an accompanying minor. All courses required for this degree must be at the 100-level or above. Upper-division electives must be at the 300- or 400-level.

** **PREREQUISITES:**

MATH 200 – Either [MATH 107 and MATH 108] or [MATH 109] with a grade of "C" or higher, or Math Placement Test.

MATH 272 – MATH 172 or MATH 107

BA 273 – CIS 110 and [MATH 107 or MATH 172]

Math skills are important in the study of economics. For this reason majors are to complete their math requirements early in their program. Students planning on graduate school are advised to take the entire calculus sequence (MATH 200, 201 and 202).

*** No more than a total of 6 credits earned in an Independent Study, or ECON 454, Economics Internship, may be used to satisfy requirements for the major (6 hours of Independent Study or 3 credits of Independent Study and 3 credits of ECON 454).

† ECON 201 and ECON 202 cannot be used to satisfy the Social Science GER requirement for this degree.

Note: A total of 120 credits is required for the BA degree, of which 48 credits must be upper-division. Students must complete at least 12 credits of their Economics courses in residence at UAA.

GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENT (GER): 37-credit General Education Requirement, including the 3-credit INTEGRATIVE CAPSTONE, is required for graduation beginning in the 2008-2009 academic year for baccalaureate students entering under 2005-2006 UAA Catalog or later.
